Two-part workshop, 14-15 November 2017, German Cultural Center, Tokyo

The German Research Foundation (DFG) supported by the Science Council of Japan and others is hosting a two-part symposium on the impact of research in the humanities and the social sciences in Germany and Japan. The first part features high profile speakers from the academic and research policy communities in both countries. The second part is devoted to presentations by leading German and Japanese sociologists and political scientists on the topics of social inequalities, challenges to democracy and transnational ties in Asian and European comparison.

The conference language is English (the first part of the symposium includes Japanese translation).
