Guidelines for submission of papers

- Those who are going to participate in the conference as a presenter are requested to submit the title and the abstract (not less than 200 words but not more than 300 words) of your presentation by **13th December 2024**. The online submission system (SOLTI) will be open in early November 2024, which will be announced in the following website:

- You are requested to submit your paper and/or the summary (over 2 pages) by **20th February 2025** after receiving the notification of acceptance of your presentation at the conference. Submission of full paper is necessary if you want to apply for the candidate work of Journal of Economic Structures (JECS) at the same time.
- If you need help for getting a visa earlier than **20th February 2025**, please submit your paper and/or the summary by **31st January 2025**.
- Completion of registration, payment of the appropriate conference fee, and the presentation are the NECESSARY CONDITIONS for securing a spot on the final program and the abstract book.
- The maximum time of your presentation is 30 minutes, including 10 minutes of discussions.
- Presenters and corresponding authors are restricted to those who hold, at minimum, a bachelor's degree.

Guidelines for organizers of special sessions

- Those who are going to organize a special session which consists of 3 or 4 presentations on a specific topic are requested to submit the proposal to the contact e-mail address by **13th December 2024**. This proposal should include all information about the theme, chairperson with affiliation and email address, title of each presentation and abstracts (not more than 300 words) for each. We recommend you create the proposal with MS-Word. In case you apply for an organized session, each presenter also needs to apply for a presentation through SOLTI.
- The maximum time of your organized special session is 120 minutes.
