① Presentation Time

2–3 minutes per presenter. The presentation must **not exceed 3 minutes**.

② Slide Submission Deadline

Thursday, March 4

③ Slide Format

One slide only, in PPT or PDF format.

The slide must be prepared in landscape format.

④ Presentation Title

The presentation title used in the Young Researchers' Introductions session must be identical to the title of your full presentation at this conference.

The purpose of this session is to promote your scheduled conference presentation and to encourage participants to attend your full session. It is not intended for introducing a different study.

⑤ Slide and Presentation Content

As time is limited, the aim is not to explain your research in detail, but to provide a concise promotional introduction that encourages the audience to attend your full presentation. There is no fixed format. However, the slide must include your name and the title of your presentation.

The use of text is optional. Images or graphs may be used if they help attract audience interest. During your presentation, you are strongly encouraged to clearly mention the date, time, and venue of your full presentation.

⑥ Publicity and Use of Photos

If all participants agree, photographs may be taken during the session and used for publicity purposes, such as on the PAPAIOS website.
